

RESIDENT MEMBERS COURSE ACCESS RIGHTS

As a Resident Member of Sandhurst Club we would like to make you aware of your course access rights and some policies associated to the use of the golf course at Sandhurst Club.

Resident Members and their guests have access to both courses 6 times per year, subject to availability as follows –

All golf bookings need to be booked through the golf shop either in person or call on 8787 7022. Resident members must present their valid ClubLINKS/Membership Card to identify them as a Resident Member.

In the interest of the Club, members and guests, Course Marshals patrol both courses checking for valid visitor's bag tags and golf member bag tags. Please have these tags clearly visible on golf bags at all times. Visitor's bag tags are issued from the Golf Shop after payment of green fees.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: As a Resident Member of Sandhurst Club, can I bring a guest for a game of golf?

A: Yes, a Resident Member can bring up to 3 guests Monday to Friday and 1 guest on Sundays and public holidays for a game of golf subject to availability. No Saturday access. Bookings can be made either in person or by calling the Golf Shop on 8787 7022. Dress regulations apply. Green fees must be paid in the Golf shop prior to play. Resident members must present their valid Clublinks/Membership Card to identify them as a resident member.

Q: I don't have any golf clubs, can I hire golf equipment from the golf shop?

A: Yes, Sandhurst Golf Shop has equipment for hire including golf shoes. The Golf Shop also has a great range of apparel, and equipment for all of your golfing needs.

Q: I have my own Golf Cart, can I use it on the golf course?

A: Yes, providing the cart is registered with the Club for golf course use. Further information regarding Golf Cart Licence and registration can be found on the Club's website www.sandhurst.com or contact reception 8787 7011.

Q: Can I bring my children out for a game of golf?

A: Yes, providing the ratio of adults to children under 12 years of age is 1 to 1. This is to ensure the safety of children at all times and monitor the correct use of the golf course. Sandhurst Club Golf Professionals run junior coaching programs to suit the beginner golfer to the elite player. Getting into golf is easy and fun, for more information on our Junior Program call the Golf Shop on 8787 7022.

Q: What are my obligations on the Golf Course:

A: For the interest of all golfers using the course we ask for your assistance in the following:

- A sand bucket is carried and used at all times.
- Please repair pitch marks on greens
- Bunkers are raked after use
- All players be aware of slow play. If you are having trouble keeping up to the group in front, please call the group behind through.
- Course Staff have right of way
- All visitors must display a valid visitor's bag tag.

Q: When I am out walking, which paths can I use?

A: Paths leading onto the golf course are for golf players only. Pedestrians can use the residential paths (coloured concrete - Inca Gold) surrounding the golf course. For the safety of pedestrians and to protect the course, the course is closed to pedestrian traffic. All dogs must be leashed at all times. Also please note that the paths are shared with golf carts and maintenance equipment.
