Sandhurst Cup Raises over \$1000 for Special Golf Clinics

The action was fast and furious at the Sandhurst Cup Worm Race to raise funds for the Limbs 4 Life golf clinics, with controversy at the finish when leading worm representing Limbs 4 Life did a U turn on the finish line and 'Oliver', from Oliver Hume real estate firm sprinted over the line.

'The Ruddster' entered by Local Member Jude Perera slid a close third. The Sandhurst Cup Worm Race took fifteen minutes to complete.

The worm race, sponsored by South East Water and Sandhurst Club, saw syndicate entries in support of Limbs 4 Life from Oliver Hume, PGA Australia, City of Dandenong, Sandhurst Club, Jude Perera MP, Sandhurst Gardeners and PlantMark Nursery.

Melissa Noonan, Executive Officer of Limbs 4 Life said the Sandhurst Cup was an outstanding success and the urgently needed funds would assist in expanding the special golf clinics for amputees at Sandhurst Club.

With the support of Christian Hamilton from the Sandhurst Club and the PGA Learning Centre, Limbs 4 Life launched the first amputee golf coaching clinic in April 2009. The purpose of these clinics is to provide amputees with the tools required to become involved with golf and have the confidence to participate.

The benefits of the amputee golf clinics are twofold; firstly golf is a wonderful sport for people living with a physical disability, more so amputees; as it enhances and challenges balance, assists with flexibility and aids core stability while promoting general well being.
